CALL MEETING TO ORDER

County Treasurer, Tracy Sedillo called the meeting to order at 2:33 p.m.

SELECTION OF CHAIRMAN

County Treasurer, Tracy Sedillo was selected to be the chairman of the investment committee.

INTRODUCTION OF COMMITTEE PURPOSE & GOALS

County Treasurer, Tracy Sedillo gave an overview of the investment committee's purpose and goals. The role of the investment committee is to determine how to invest Torrance County's money that is not immediately needed for day to day operations. The money has to be evenly invested in all qualifying banks within Torrance County per New Mexico State Statutes. Money can also be invested with the Local Government Investment Pool through the New Mexico State Treasurer's Office, which is where Torrance County's investments are currently. The Committee would determine what is available for investment and what term of investment would be most advantageous for Torrance County. The investment committee would then make a recommendation to the County Commission for final decision.

Commissioner, Javier Sanchez gave on overview of his vision for the committee to determine the investment options for the PILT money and various strategies of investment/expenditure of that fund. The committee will determine various options but will not have any authority on voting for options. Although they will be able to determine options the Commission is the only one that has the final vote/say as to how that money is invested.

STATUTES

County Treasurer, Tracy Sedillo explained to the members that the committee packet contains some relevant statutes pertaining to public investments that they can review. Copy attached.

TERM OF PUBLIC MEMBERS

There was discussion on whether or not to set term limits for the public members but nothing was formally decided.

CURRENT INVESTMENT POLICY

There was discussion of updating the investment policy that was adopted in 1988. Copy of that policy is attached.

SCHEDULE OF CURRENT INVESTMENTS

County Treasurer, Tracy Sedillo gave a recap of the County's current investments that are all in the Local Government Investment Pool with the NM State Treasurer's Office. Copy attached.

HOW TO PROCEED

Discussion followed about how the committee should proceed. It was decided that County Treasurer, Tracy Sedillo would contact all the banks in Torrance County to give a presentation of investment options at the next meeting. She will also work on a draft copy of a new investment policy.

Commissioner, Javier Sanchez will work on a form for funding requests that can used by agencies requesting funding assistance from the County Commission.

NEXT MEETING & MEETING FREQUENCY

It was decided that the meeting frequency would be monthly. The next meeting will be June 6, 2017 at 8:45 a.m. in the County Commission Chambers at the Administrative Offices of Torrance County.

In May 2013, Governor Susana Martinez issued Executive Order 2013-006 requiring state agencies and other public bodies to have complete audits pursuant to the Audit Act and establishing uniform funding criteria before an entity can receive capital outlay funding. In November 2013, Attorney-General Gary K. King issued an opinion (13-03) on the matter and stated that the governor is not permitted under current law and the constitutional separation of powers doctrine to unilaterally withhold capital outlay funds properly appropriated by the legislature.

DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENTS

Capital assets must be owned by the county or a political subdivision of the state. If the asset will be leased to another organization, the owner will be asked to certify that the item is leased at fair market value and that the asset will be properly maintained *prior to the release of funding*.

Economic development projects that represent a public-private partnership under the Local Economic Development Act (LEDA) require local or regional government approval and a project participation agreement in accordance with ordinances adopted pursuant to the LEDA.
