**Age requirements for each candidate:**

**As of January 1, 2018,**

**TORRANCE COUNTY FAIR QUEEN must be between 15 and 19 years old**

**MISS TORRANCE COUNTY FAIR must be between 12 and 14 years old**

**LITTLE MISS TORRANCE COUNTY FAIR must be between 8 and 11 years old**

**GENERAL RULES**

- Contestants must be residents of Torrance County OR attend school in Torrance County
- Contestants must have never been married or pregnant
- Contestants must have parent/guardian written consent to enter the contest
- Contestants must be willing to reign for one year
- Contestants must wear for the competition, and for all Fair sanctioned events, collared shirts that cover the shoulders; blue or black pants/jeans and plain regular heeled boots or tennis shoes. (Pants may not be tucked into boots for the competition)
- Elected Fair Queens must be present at every day of the 2018 Torrance County Fair and present at all Fair functions as required by the Torrance County Fair Board. Any candidate unable to attend any assigned Fair function MUST notify the Fair Queen Superintendent BEFORE the scheduled event. If any deadline is missed, the Queen may be dismissed and not allowed to participate further in Queen duties
- Elected Fair Queens must present ribbons at all livestock shows during the Torrance County Fair
- Elected Fair Queens must present champion awards at the Awards Parade of Champions
- Elected Fair Queens must ride in the 2018 Torrance County Fair Parade and the 2019 Old Timers Day Parade
- Elected Torrance County Fair Queens must be willing to represent Torrance County at official functions during the entire reigning year
- Elected Torrance County Fair Queens must be accompanied by a parent, guardian or Fair representative when appearing throughout the reigning year at any required functions

**Torrance County Fair Queen Competition-Saturday, August 4, 2018**

**6 PM - Torrance County Fair Livestock Show Arena**

- Contestants will enter the ring as a group
- Each contestant will be asked to state her name, age, and why she wishes to represent Torrance County as a Fair Queen
- Each contestant will be asked to step forward and model her outfit
- One individual question will be randomly selected by a judge and asked of each contestant

- Judges will score entrants
  - Poise 20%
  - Personality 30%
  - Appearance 20%
  - Communication 30%
- Winners will be announced and presented
